In the good ol' days, the Health Information Management (aka Medical Records) department was the steward of the paper medical record, painstakingly filing appropriate documents in the appropriate location within the right patient's chart. Today, Electronic Medical Records (EMRs) bring new challenges to properly storing information in the EMR. CHITA is offering a series of programs to help you move ahead regardless of where you are in the process of using EMRs.

All individuals - physicians, nurses, health information management professionals, IT leadership and staff, administrators (acute and ambulatory settings), risk managers, transcriptionists, legal professionals, vendors, and others impacted by the transition to and use of EMRs are encouraged to attend.

The next session scheduled for January 28 will address topics relating to the new challenges of accessing medical records including password issuance and management, auditing, patient access to medical records, and balancing the risk of access. Presentations from the clinical perspective will include the system-wide use of electronic medical records (between hospital and ambulatory care), shared problem list between in patient and outpatient settings, success stories regarding access, clinical interfaces among others.

You will hear from professionals in WA State discuss their hands-on experience with what worked and what did not work. The topics will range from standards (national and state), auditing medical records for access, risk management concerns, clinical perspectives and state medical record laws.
